The Bridge is a homework assistance, tutoring and learning community center that reaches out to students and adults in a predominantly Latino neighborhood. For the past 20 years, on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday afternoons during the regular school year, volunteers have shared God's love through Bible stories, Scripture memorization, homework assistance/tutoring, mentoring, computer use, and meals. For those who wish to attend Wednesday night Faith Kids Clubs and youth programs on the main campus at EFCC, transportation is provided. On two weeknights, an English as a Second Language (ESL) course and a computer lab also are offered for the adults from the neighborhood.



The goal of The Bridge staff is to provide a safe and positive place for the students and adults from the neighborhood to study and learn about Jesus. We help students make smart, positive choices, and encourage them to work and study hard.

Those who work at the Bridge desire that all of the students involved seek the Lord and value the lifestyle God wants for them. Through the friendships, testimonies and counseling of the Ministry Partners, many have come to know Jesus Christ as their Savior.
