If you've logged into our app or registered for an event, then use that same email address and password to log in to your account here www.efcc.org/statements. In the right-hand corner, click on **Your Name** and the word **Profile**. Under your name, address and contact information, click on the **Giving** tab. Then click **Statements**. Finally, by clicking the year **2019**, you will see this year's current statement, which can be downloaded or printed.
