Faith Kids Lebanon Trip (July 13-28)

Trip Goal: \$23,800 | Raised to Date: \$5,327 | Amount to Go: \$18,472

This GPS team of seven people will travel to Lebanon to love and witness to Syrian refugees and their families. They will be working with in-country partners to hold multiple vacation Bible school programs for refugee children during day. In the evenings, they will visit the refugees in their homes, tents or apartments to share God's love with them.



Prayer Requests

- That the team members will rely on God's wisdom and strength to plan, prepare and carry out His vision for this trip.
- For the Lord's guidance as the team engages both believers and non-believers.
- For the team to trust in God's safety and protection throughout the trip.

High School Global Leadership Initiative, Albania (July 18-31)

Trip Goal: \$64,153 | Raised to Date: \$48,754 | Amount to Go: \$15,399

The Collide high school students in the Global Leadership Initiative will reach out to urban Albanian students, who normally don't have the opportunity to go to camp, by offering a summer camp designed around conversational English. EFCC students will teach Bible lessons, run games and activities, hold workshops, and build relationships as counselors, all with the purpose of sharing the love of Jesus.



Prayer Requests

- For the team as they plan and prepare to run a week-long camp.
- For connections and relationships to develop so EFCC students can grow deeper ties with the local students and ministry partners.
- That EFCC students would be sensitive to the moving of the Holy Spirit, and that their faith and world view would continue to grow.
- For those in the Albanian church to continue to grow and be encouraged.

College India Trip (July 23-August 8)

Trip Goal: \$25,656 | Raised to Date: \$14,714 | Amount to Go: \$10,942

Traveling to northern India, theWELL College ministry will partner with Operation Mobilization and the Good Shepherd Church to reach the Dalit people. The team will serve young kids by running a VBS and sports camps to share the Gospel and Christ's love.



Prayer Requests

- That the children's VBS curriculum will help clearly communicate the Gospel message of new life in Jesus.
- For the team to be prepared to face the challenges of the Dalit people, and to be truly helpful to the poor and those seeking to grow in Christ.
- For the spiritual maturity of the team members: that their spiritual walks would not be compromised during the trip preparation time.

Spanish-Language Ministry Mexico Trip (July 29-August 5)

Trip Goal: \$16,565 | Raised to Date: \$2,341 | Amount to Go: \$14,224

This 17-person team from EFCC's Spanish-Language Ministry will travel to El Paraiso, a small community in Chiapas, Mexico, to minister and serve. They will put on a VBS for the children and events targeted for the older youth. While there, they will train the leaders as a strategy to empower the leaders of Chiapas.

- That this inaugural GPS trip for the Spanish-Language Ministry would go well and that long-term partners can be established.
- For the team members as they meet and prepare for the trip.
- For faith in God as they continue to raise support.

Short-term Worker, Morgan (June-August)

Trip Goal: \$4,705 | Raised to Date: \$3,627 | Amount to Go: \$1,078

Morgan will be part of a team of five individuals serving in North Africa. She will learn the language and culture, as well as serve the EFCC Global Outreach (GO) partners living there. She seeks to explore and gain both a heart for, and perspective on, unreached Muslim people. From North Africa she will travel to Spain and join EFCC GO Partners Deric and Amber Moen. She will join their summer ministry as they build relationships and minister to those on a spiritual pilgrimage.

- For discernment as she pursues long-term service overseas.
- For strength and courage when telling others about Christ, and that His love would abound from her; for a continued desire to deepen her relationship with the Lord.
