We also help send South American missionaries to North Africa, Chinese missionaries to Central Asia, and Middle Eastern missionaries to Europe. Jesus' disciples are the most global and diverse community on the planet today and missionaries are now being sent from everywhere to everywhere!



Supporting MOVEMENTS

God is stirring up new movements of small, indigineous and rapidly multiplying churches in some of the most hostile and unlikely places. As a result, more Muslims have come to Christ in the past 14 years than in the past 14 centuries combined! Thousands of small village churches are multiplying across India despite persecution. On any given Sunday, there are more believers meeting in Chinese underground churches than in all of the cathedrals of Europe! Young people in Islamic North Africa are being discipled through sports. Groups of disciples, led by women, are secretly worshipping in Iran. God is truly doing something new and EFCC is prayerfully partnering with indigenous leaders to help foster powerful Gospel movements in 22 countries.





As Jesus' disciples, we seek justice, we love mercy, and we walk humbly into every circumstance. We are moved by compassion to care for those who are suffering, to stand for those who are being oppressed, and to defend those who are vulnerable. Through one act of loving service at a time, and one changed life helping to change another, we bring Jesus' Kingdom here onto earth.
