Next Apologetics Class | Starts Thursday, January 20, 7-8pm online

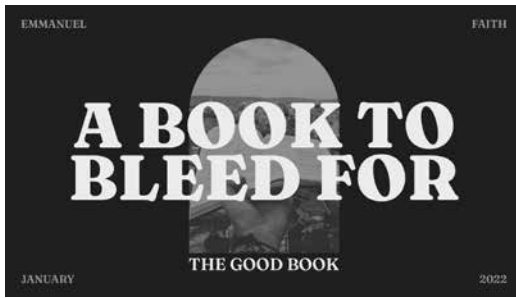
