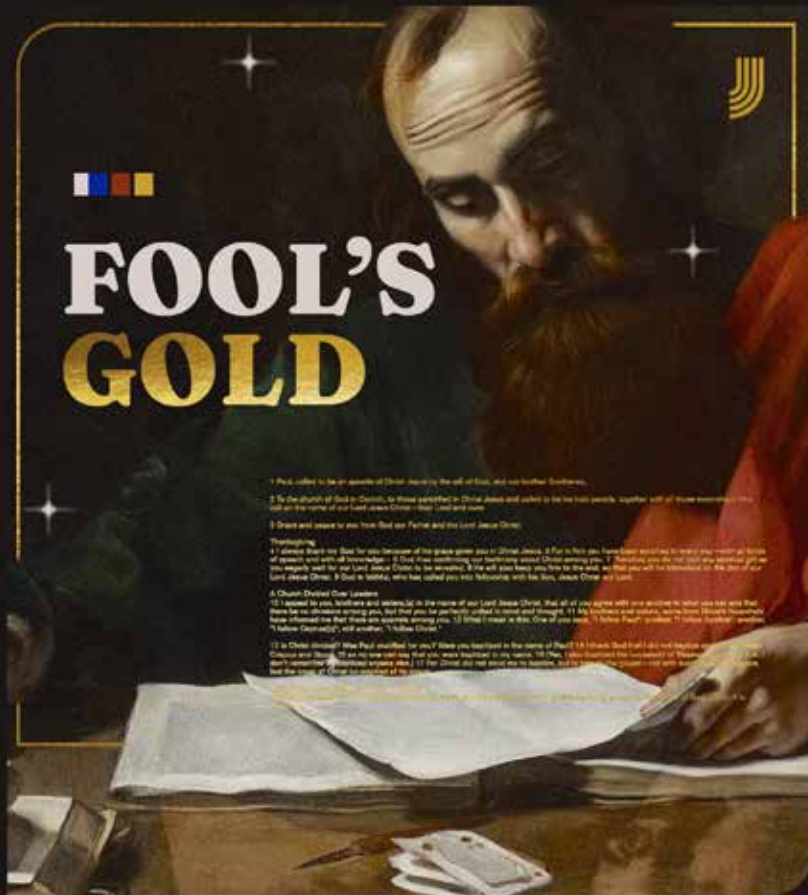
Baptism Class | Sunday, February 27, 9am-10:15am, Ed. Center, Room 3

Bible Exhibit Coming to Emmanuel Faith in March

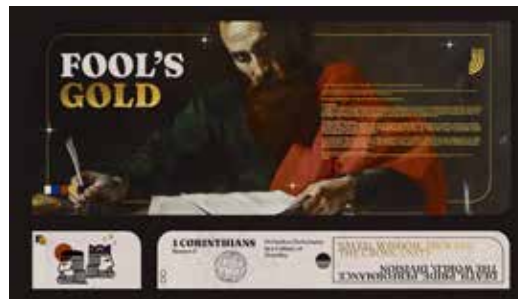
Please note updated dates for this event!
