Read 1 Corinthians 8; 10:23-11:1

Josh taught us that the pattern to follow when we encounter teachings in the Scriptures on more obscure or no longer relevant matters is to practice identifying the Historic Truth, the Eternal (Timeless) Truth, and figuring out how to apply it today. We have to figure out what it meant “back then” to the original recipients, what the timeless principle is, and then how we should apply it today.

2. What are the challenges and benefits that accompany this process for understanding and applying Scripture? Why?
3. Have you ever been in a situation with other people in which you discerned that how you lived out your faith “depended” on how others perceived things?
