Ministry Spotlight: Yemen

Yemen's strategic location at the entrance to the Red Sea put it in the middle of prosperous trade routes between Asia, Africa and Europe, however the modern nation of Yemen has been plagued by civil war, corruption, tribal violence and economic hardship. It was the first place coffee was commercially grown, so maybe lift up a prayer for Yemen next time you enjoy your morning coffee!



Yemen is a 100% Muslim country, but God is doing something new there and we are a part of it. EFCC is helping train leaders of Yemen's growing Christian movement made up of small groups of disciples who are multiplying across networks of friends and neighbors despite extreme persecution.

Here is one of their stories:

"There were 12 new Yemeni believers baptized. These men and women risk their lives and comfort to answer God's call. The government considers Muslims who turn to Christ infidels. They are routinely assassinated or beaten into submission to Islam. Some of these 12 Arab Christians have faced beatings while locked away for days without food. They have risked rejection by their families and been ostracized by society because they found Christ and their eternal hope in his salvation worth dying for."

PRAYER REQUESTS: Pray for the men and women who are risking their lives to share their faith. Pray that more Yemeni leaders will be trained and discipled. Pray for those who are suffering from the humanitarian crisis in their country.
