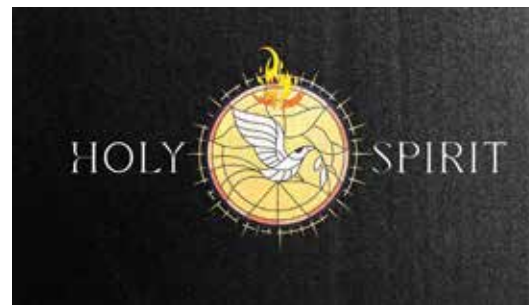
Here is a key upcoming fall class for you to consider:

## EFCC On Mission... Around the World

### Gospel-centered Education for Syrian Children



It has been a decade since the start of the Syrian civil war. More than half of Syria's population has been forcibly displaced, resulting in 6.8 million refugees and asylum seekers who have fled the country. Most are residing in Lebanon and Jordan.

Through the Emmanuel Faith Outreach Fund, we partner with churches in Lebanon and Jordan to provide Gospel-centered education to 1,400+ Syrian children each month. Each of the four holistic learning centers we support cares for the social, emotional, and educational needs of the children and their parents.



#### Prayer Requests:

Pray that the new school year might be a symbol of hope for families and their children.

Pray that teachers will continue to meet the needs of the students enrolled in the learning centers.

Pray that the hope found only in Jesus will shine brightly through the lives of the workers who interact with Syrian families.

Journey of Hope offers entry-level volunteer opportunities in a variety of one time or ongoing ways including ESL

lessons for men and women, helping men study for driving tests, women's sewing, homework help for children, and more. Events throughout the year include picnics and Christmas parties with volunteers and refugees.
