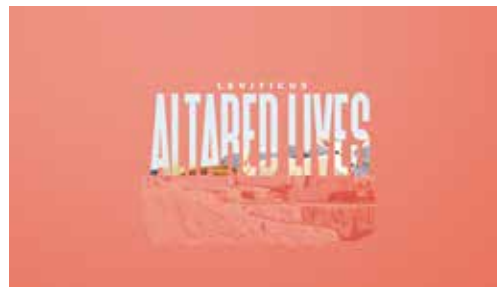
Set Free: *Christ-centered Recovery Ministry*
