San Diego churches collaborate to make a Kingdom impact in the Middle East





Emmanuel Faith is one of five San Diego churches committed to pooling resources and efforts to impact the Middle East. Our vision is to help local churches in the Middle East transform their communities for Christ, with a special focus on serving refugees. Since 2016, this group has sponsored sustainable, community development projects, funded education initiatives for refugee children, partnered with Middle Eastern churches to make disciples, and sent many short-term teams.

There are now more than 10 in-country churches and organizations throughout the Middle East and North Africa that are actively furthering the Gospel in collaboration with San Diego churches.
