Hey, church family! Let's come together for an all-church beach day.



Sending Chinese Missionaries to the Least Reached

Over the past four decades, Christianity has grown faster in China than anywhere else in the world. Chinese believers are now sending missionaries to spread the Gospel to unreached people groups.



Through a generous gift to

the Outreach Fund, we sent 10 Chinese believers to a 6 month residential training program. They learned cross-cultural skills, language, and disciple-making strategies. We also sent 3 Chinese missionaries to serve in countries that we may not have otherwise had access to.
