Pray for North Africa

North Africa has been left reeling after experiencing two major catastrophes this past week. A rare, powerful earthquake struck Morocco late last Friday night, killing more than 2,800 people and damaging buildings from villages in the Atlas Mountains to the historic city of Marrakesh. Then on Monday, Eastern Libya experienced once-in-a-lifetime floods as torrential rain caused two dams to burst. The death toll is still unknown as 10,000 people are unaccounted for.



We have strategically focused on North Africa by supporting global workers, sending teams, and training indigenous disciple-makers. Emmanuel Faith supports two missionary families in the region, and a short-term team spent part of last summer in Casablanca. In Libya, we have helped train men and women who have seen the Gospel transform their communities. The events of this past week have been harrowing to watch from a world away.



As the reality of the devastation continues to unfold, let us remember the people of Morocco and Libya and the God who desires to bring hope and peace to each person impacted by these events.

Here are some ways to pray:

- For displaced families, those unaccounted for, the injured, and those who are grieving the loss of loved ones.
- For the rescue and relief workers
- For the church to be bold in a Christ-centered response, and for opportunities to bring healing physically, emotionally, and spiritually.
