Learning His Way

(Every week in these studies, we will ask questions about the Scriptures that try to help us Discover the unique Way of Jesus that is found in the text.)

- 2. Read Genesis 17:5; 1 Kings 8:60; Isaiah 56:7; Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; and Revelation 7:9
- 3. Have multiple people within your group use their own words to summarize what these Scriptures reveal about God's heart.

Forming His Heart

(This is the part of the study where we work on our own hearts. "How does my character need to grow and change because of this passage?")

- 4. Considering the story of Jesus did not begin on the soil of the United States, rather the Middle East and spread from there, we are to think of our Founding Fathers of the Christian faith in a global sense. Share with the group how this statement impacts you.
- 5. We live in a time when much all around us is explainable. Define the word 'supernatural'. Why or why not, is it important to embrace the supernatural aspect of living a life of faith.
- 6. Acts 1:8 revealed that Jesus asks His followers to wait for the Holy Spirit. What it is that the Holy Spirit brings those whom He lives within. List as many characteristics as possible.
- 7. Now read Acts 7:54-60, the story of Stephen. What does this reveal that waiting can look like in the life of a believer?
- 8. EFCC's Vision:

To be an inter-ethnic, inter-generational community of disciples partnering with Jesus to bring about renewal in Escondido, North County, and to the ends of the earth.

Now take a moment to self-evaluate how <u>you</u> are on mission with Jesus. Do you live your daily life with this Kingdom lens? Share with the group at least one way you are partnering with Jesus on His mission.

Joining His Mission

(This is the part of the study that we ask, "What would God want us to do because of this passage?")
