Via EFCC the App (get our App at efcc.org/app)

Open the EFCC App and tap "Give" in the bottom bar.

Tap on the "person icon" in upper right corner.

Tap on "Manage Account."

Sign in either via cell phone or email/password.

If via cell phone, login via the code that gets texted to you.

Tap on the menu "hamburger" (3 lines) in the upper left corner. Tap "Giving Statements."

Tap "View" to see your statement (it should download to your phone or device).

On the Internet (efcc.org/give or scan the QR code below)

On our website, click the "Give Now" button to open our giving portal.

Click on "Your Account" in the upper right hand corner. Choose "Manage account" (you will need to log in). Sign in (mobile number, email or password) or if you don't have an account, create an account.

Click "Giving Overview."
