Partner Highlight: New Generations

In 2023, Emmanuel Faith began a strategic partnership with African churches focusing on sending missionaries to the Sahel region. We love their single-minded approach of mobilizing disciples that make disciples resulting in churches that plant churches.

"Like Jesus' parable of the seed that fell on good soil, each individual seed has the power to create countless future generations of new seeds. Our ministry compass points to the pioneer places, where the Gospel has never been or has never flourished."

During 2023 alone, God has used the disciple making process to plant 15,288 new churches with 233,826 new women and men becoming Christ followers. This is a staggering average of over 15 churches per day!

Below is a story from New Generations that illustrates how God is using simple things to build his Kingdom.



Joshna was invited to a Bible study, which was to be accompanied by a meal in her neighbor's home. The people of her community love the fellowship of mealtime, so Joshna was delighted to go.

She heard stories of lifetransformation from the group, so she kept attending. Joshna also got a Bible and began to read it on her own.

She discovered many truths that were new to her, and she heard people sharing their stories about God working in their lives. All of this amazed Joshna, especially when she realized that God had been working in her own life even when she didn't know Him personally.

Joshna and her family eventually came to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior and were all baptized. Today, Joshna leads a discipleship group in her neighborhood with the hope, as people turn to the Lord as she did, to see it develop into a church that transforms many more lives. And to think, one simple meal is all it took!

In June, a team from EFCC will travel to New Generations Catalyst Camp in Nairobi, Kenya. They will meet church planters and group leaders from the region as they participate in training sessions. Pray for relationships to continue to be built between EFCC and New Generations disciple-makers!
