En Español has experienced a season of growth, and we are excited to see the special ways we'll see God working in our Spanish-speaking venue! Since January 2024 our average monthly attendance has grown to over 200 people in our Sunday worship services. Last Easter, we had a record attendance of 303 people. God is on the move and we are seeing something special going on. Also, we celebrate that more Spanish-speaking congregants are getting involved in serving in various areas of Emmanuel Faith including Faith Kids, our Security Team, Men's Ministry, Love Esco, and many more. Since this year we focused on helping people from En Español to get connected, we experienced an increase in attendance in our life groups and monthly large groups of men and women. About 50% of our Spanish-speaking congregants are part of a group. We cannot do life alone, and these groups have created space to connect more deeply and encourage one another as we learn to live in the way of Jesus. Please pray that this number continues to grow. During our study through John's gospel, the En Español family has experienced a special time of individual and communal spiritual growth and commitment to the Lord. God has been moving in beautiful ways!

We continue to be thankful for our Lay Counselors, Pastoral Counseling Team, and partnerships with multiple counseling centers in San Diego County that provide counseling services to our church family. Our volunteer Care and Visitation Teams continue to grow, offering encouragement, rides, resources, care, and hope to people in our church family and community. Sadly, many have recently lost loved ones.

We are grateful for a compassionate team of volunteers and staff who provide care, resources, and bereavement counseling to those who are grieving. Through this difficult process, many are coming to a deeper understanding of God's love and care amidst some of life's most trying circumstances. God continues to provide an abundance of volunteers and a generous church family that supports the many physical, emotional, and mental health needs in our church and community. The Preschool Ministry began in August of 2019 as a small preschool serving 60, 3-5-year-olds in both full-day and half-day programs. This past year we have expanded to serve 132 children ages 12 months to 5 years old. A huge highlight of our year was opening the Infant and Toddler program supporting families with the care of their little ones. We have learned there is a great need for Infant & Toddler care and hope to continue expanding in this area to reach additional families in Escondido and throughout North County. Through this ministry we have been sharing the love of Jesus with families who attend EFCC, attend other local churches, and a growing number of unchurched families and nonbelievers. Please pray for the anticipated growth over the next year or two and for the right people to be called to serve God's precious children.

The Junior High Ministry exists to help students learn to walk in the way and with the heart of Jesus. This past year that happened in weekly programs with teaching and a focus on God's Word at the Sunday Study with Core Groups led by 12 volunteer leaders, and the Wednesday Night Outreach with 8 leaders. The ministry took 110 people to both Summer and Winter Camp, 45 people to the Extreme Retreat, for extreme learning, 14 people to bring Christmas presents to children in East Tijuana, 15 to build a house in Mexico in one day, and had lots of activities to encourage Christian friendships. In addition, the Jr. High room remodel (needed due to a broken water pipe in 2020) was completed and it is great to have our own space to meet in at the church.






