A **GOOD MEAL** keeps you seated at **THE TABLE**.

If we take the Lord's Supper in a wrong **MANNER** or wrong **MINDSET** we compromise the meal and our gathering.

- We don't gather around the table with people we **LIKE**, we gather with people who need **GRACE**.
- The wrong manner we sometimes gather in is one of <u>FAVORITISM</u>, <u>PARTIALITY</u>, and <u>PRIDE</u>.
- We often hold onto the <u>GRUDGES</u> that make giving and receiving <u>GRACE</u> impossible.

The **SMELL** of the company we find ourselves in can cause us to question our **PLACE**. (Do we "smell" of favoritism, partiality, pride, and grudges?)

If you place your **HOPE** in people you'll eventually be **COMPELLED** to leave.

The common **HUMILITY** of those at the table leads to unbreakable **UNITY**.

The **ONLY THING** that will keep you seated at God's table is the **MEAL** that He has prepared for you and for everyone.

By taking this meal you're saying: "God I'm **GIVING UP GETTING EVEN** because what you've given me in Jesus is **GREATER**."

GIVE the same grace that you've been **GIVEN**.
