From the day our church was founded in 1939, global missions has been at the heart of EFCC. We stand today on the shoulders of hundreds of ordinary people who have been sent by EFCC to do extraordinary things. They have not only impacted the world, but also deeply shaped who we are as a church.

We continue our mission today, always creatively adapting our methods to our times, while our focus remains unchanged—taking the Good News to those who need it most. We hope today helps you connect with what God is doing around the world.

Why Global Missions?

4 out of 10 people on our planet will live their entire lives without ever hearing the Gospel or meeting a follower of Jesus.

We are laser-focused on changing this reality among the least reached people groups around the world.

EFCC supports 64 missionaries. We send our best to pioneer new work, mobilize and train leaders, build strategic partnerships, and foster indigenous Gospel movements.

We also partner with 13 Gospel movements in 28 countries. More Muslims have come to Christ in the past 14 years than in the previous 14 centuries. Thousands of village churches are growing in India despite persecution. Underground believers in China outnumber those in Europe's cathedrals. Young people in North Africa are being discipled through sports, and women-led groups secretly worship in Iran.

Jesus' disciples are the most global and diverse community on the planet today, and missionaries are now being sent from everywhere to everywhere!





What is the Outreach Fund and how is it used?

While the General Fund supports the day-to-day ministry of our church, the Outreach Fund supports our ministry outside the walls of the church. The Outreach Fund relies on special gifts of mission-minded members, who give above and beyond their regular tithes.

Every dollar goes to mission work. This includes our missionaries and strategic partners around the world, as well as partnerships and projects in the community.

Every dollar is multiplied. Our long history and networks of trusted relationships enable us to work with amazing partners and to ensure that every dollar we invest produces lasting fruit that will continue to multiply.

Every dollar is evaluated annually. A small army of volunteers and advisory teams invest countless hours in communicating with our missionaries, studying partner reports, and prayerfully evaluating projects to ensure the best stewardship of resources.

Every dollar makes a difference. When we pull together our individual gifts, however large or small, our collective impact is far more focused, strategic, and impactful than what we could ever hope to achieve individually.
