Learning His Way: Discovering the Way of Jesus

- 1. Read Revelation 20:1-10 out loud together. What words or phrases stand out to you? What questions do you have?
- 2. Read Matthew 6:7-14. In verse 10, Jesus prays, "Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." How does Revelation 20 challenge you or give you a bigger picture of Jesus' prayer in Matthew 6?



Forming His Heart: How is God shaping my character and helping me to grow?

3. We each have areas of life where we like to stay in control. Where might God be exposing places in your own heart that still resist His reign—and how can that awareness become a place of grace or purpose rather than shame or condemnation?



Joining His Mission: What is God calling me/us to do?

- 4. How might living from the confidence that Jesus' victory is already certain help you face challenges, temptations, or spiritual opposition this week?
- 5. One day, the wall will fall, and Jesus' rule will be fully established. And today, we are called to live as a royal priesthood. How might your everyday life—your work, home, or relationships—be a place where His reign is practiced and visible to those around you?

Close your time together reading the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:9-13.

Meditate on Proverbs 4:20-27, pausing and reflecting on verse 23. Spend some time this week in quiet reflection before the Lord, asking: "How healthy is my heart? What is flowing from it?"
