Tune My Heart Sermon Series: Special Prayer Focus (part 3)

During the *Tune My Heart* sermon series, we've been calling everyone to prayer. Each day this week, please take some time to pray and ask Jesus to tune your heart to what he has for you. And consider taking part in our recent 21-day generosity experiment (see note below the prayer prompts).

MONDAY: Prayer of Gratitude — "Tune my heart to grace."

Father, open my eyes to the grace You've poured into my life. Before I think about giving anything away, help me remember everything You've given me — forgiveness, hope, breath, provision, relationships, and Yourself. Tune my heart to gratitude so that generosity flows naturally from joy, not pressure.

TUESDAY: Prayer of Formation — "Shape me into a giver."

Lord, generosity is not just a financial act; it's a journey of formation. Shape my character so that giving becomes who I am, not just something I do. Form me into someone who reflects Your self-giving love in small and big ways every day.

WEDNESDAY: Prayer for Freedom — "Break the power of scarcity in me."

God, release me from fear, scarcity thinking, and the belief that I never have enough. Lead me into the freedom of Your abundance — the freedom the Macedonians found. Help me trust that I can give because You will supply what I need and more.

THURSDAY: Prayer of Practice — "Grow me through disciplined giving."

Lord, help me build a rule of life that includes faithful tithing, spontaneous generosity, and relational hospitality. Use these practices to retrain my desires, loosen my grip on possessions, and cultivate a cheerful heart.

FRIDAY: Prayer of Participation — "Use my giving for Your mission."

Father, take what I offer — my resources, time, and hospitality — and multiply it for Your kingdom. Let my generosity bring glory to You, bless others, and demonstrate the gospel in real and tangible ways. Make me part of the story You're writing at Emmanuel Faith through joyful generosity.

21-Day Generosity Experiment

- (1) Pray for a heart of generosity.
- (2) Start giving something.
- (3) Set aside a small amount to bless someone spontaneously.

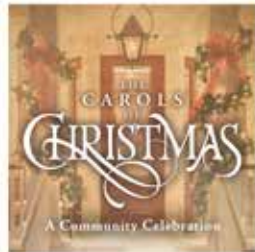
