What does the journey through uncertain times require?

Faith in God's **plan** & **promises**:

- 1. ... means we're willing to go down inconvenient **paths**.
- **2.** ... can sometimes look like **complacency**.
- **3.** ... often looks like **obedience** to earthly authorities.
 - a. This is not agreeing with or condoning their policies.
 - **b.** This is done only because it pleases **God**.
- **4.** ... is trusting that his reign, while at times hitches/hitches

Belief in Ourselves: The God of armies arrives when we fight for him.

Faith in God: The Prince of Peace arrives on his-own terms.

Faith is the only thing that survives the **unexpected**.

God will accomplish his **known** promises through completely **unknown** plans and people.

- Have you <u>forgotten</u> his promises?
- Are you demanding to know his plans?

Faith and obedience along the **inconvenient journey** require that we trust in Jesus' **eternal sovereignty**.
