The Gospel Message:

Forgiveness and freedom from sin come by **grace** through **faith** in Jesus Christ **alone**,
changing a person from the **inside out**.

The Main Point: If the gospel message is **changed**, it **damages** everything! Therefore,
it must be **protected**.
(Isaiah 64:6; 2 Cor. 5:21)

We must protect ...

1. The Gospel's **authority**. (6:11; 1:11-12)

The Point: The gospel has **divine origin**. (Rom 1:16)

2. The Gospel's **content**. (6:12-13)

The Key Insight: Circumcision symbolized a commitment to **keep the whole Old Testament Law**. (James 2:10; 2 Tim. 1:14)

3. The Gospel's **glory**. (6:14-15; 1 Cor. 2:2; 1 John 5:19)

The Point: God is not simply concerned about **rehabilitation**, but about **regeneration**.
(2 Cor. 5:17)

4. The Gospel's **blessings**. (6:16-18)
