2. There is a lot in this text! After reading through it as a group, begin the night by sharing some high-level observations you have. Consider:
 - What are some things this passage teaches us about God?
 - What are some things this passage teaches us about people?
 - Why do you think this passage is in our Bibles? Why did you answer the way you did?
3. There are four main things this text teaches us about how to make decisions. Remind each other what they are, and then consider these questions for discussion:
 - Is there one you tend to do better than the others? Why?
 - Is there one you tend to do poorer than the others? Why?
 - What do you think about the idea that we most often get clear leading but not clear answers when we are seeking God's guidance?
 - What does this teach us about God?
 - What does this teach us about people?
 - What does this teach us about God's relationship with His people?
