PSALM 132

 - What is required to successfully make this pivot?
 - In what ways do you need to make this pivot?
 - What is one thing you can do to live with this perspective more regularly?

3. The final pivot is from f_____ G_____ to f_____ G_____.
 - What do you think about this pivot? If you grew up in the church, was this the way you were raised? Why do you think that might be?
 - How does thinking this way change the way you live?
 - What might it mean to practice this pivot?

4. There are a lot of potential applications from this message. What is one you can choose to practice this week? You would you tell about your decision?
